1. Welcome and Introductions

The Principal began the meeting by welcoming all attendees and asked everyone to introduce themselves.

2. Review of Agenda

The Principal reviewed the agenda, beginning with the SAC Agreement and discussing the current vacancies on the council.

7. New Lunch Program

The principal introduced the new lunch program and outlined challenges, particularly the shortage of kitchen staff this year. She emphasized her commitment to finding solutions, aiming to have the kitchen fully operational by next year.

Two SAC members offered to explore temporary solutions, such as inviting a food truck to the school parking area once a week or partnering with a food delivery app for school orders.

8. Provincial SAC Conference Updates

The principal shared information from the recent Provincial SAC Conference, including details about the SAC Grant, funding requests, and carry-over funding. She encouraged members to brainstorm new ideas to help the school secure additional grant funding this year.

9. Student Success Plan (SSP) Goals

The principal discussed the SSP goals, emphasizing the importance of implementing a short-cycle plan to ensure measurable improvements for students.
