1. Call to Order & Agenda Review

2. Approval of Previous Minutes

6. Enrollment Configuration for 2025–2026

- Anticipated configuration:
 - o Grade 6: 2 French Immersion + 6 English = 8 classes total
 - Expectation of small class sizes.

- Student body size remains steady, but numbers are shifting from junior high to Grade 6.
- Class size caps:
 - Grades 3–6: 25 students (with flexibility)
 - Grades 7–9: 28 students (with flexibility)

7. SAC Budget Update
